Position:

The **Ground Systems Analyst** works hand-in-hand with the rest of the operations team, which is based in Saint-Hubert Quebec and ensures a healthy fleet of spacecraft. From observing ozone particulates to imaging natural disasters to hunting comets, each mission is unique with different needs and support requirements. The Ground Systems Analyst ensures terrestrial systems are maintained for successful mission operations, from the data links and network security through to the hardware processing the various application layers. The nature of the operational environment requires support of mission procedures, troubleshooting tightly integrated and complex systems, while contributing to a 24/7 on-call schedule. Participating in the Launch and Early Orbit (LEOP) phase, Commissioning and Routine phases and the Decommissioning phase, the Ground Systems Analyst is a challenging position that helps ensure all mission deliverables. The GSA position contains four different levels depending on employee qualifications and responsibilities: Entry, Intermediate, Senior and Lead.

Responsibilities:

- You have a strong technical background with an inquisitive and curious mindset, able to investigate sometimes very complex scenarios to understand, explain and recommend solutions to both technical and non-technical audiences
- You are comfortable expressing your opinions and can provide expert advice. We continually foster our team culture in an inclusive and professional fashion
- You will perform network and systems administration functions, such as:
 - assess the performance of all systems
 - o identify any system level issues
 - o upgrade and develop new functions
 - maintain or improve the system hardware and software to increase system availability or performance

- You will work to ensure operational issues are resolved in a timely manner and provide support on an on-call basis

Qualifications:

- Post-secondary technical education, either
 - o a D.E.C. or equivalent as a minimum
 - University Degree in Computer Science, Engineering, or equivalent
- Fluent knowledge of both spoken and written English is required and French is an asset
- Experience with one or more of the following elements would be an asset:
 - Languages; C/C++, SQL, Unix Shell Script, Matlab, Labview, Perl, Python, PHP, Java

 - o Best practices around management, control, and monitoring of server infrastructure
 - Network troubleshooting and problem resolution

 - Backup and recovery software and methodologies
